

Crestview Animal Hospital Feline Vaccine Protocols

Feline Annuals:

- Physical exam
- 1 yr Rabies
- FVRCP (DRC) Vaccine
- FeLV Vaccine
- Fecal exam and/or deworming

The feline leukemia vaccine is recommended for all kittens and then annually for most cats. This disease is spread from cat to cat so if the pet has any contact with the outside or other cats then they should be vaccinated.

All kittens should be Felv/FIV combo tested. Also any adult cat that is adopted and has no documented history of a negative FeLV/FIV result should be tested.

3 yr Rabies vaccines are not recommended in cats. The 1yr Feline Rabies vaccine that we use is specifically designed for cats and is safer than a 3 yr vaccine.

Heartworm prevention is available and recommended for cats year round, as well as flea and tick prevention.
